FORT BRAGG, N. C. – The four finalists for Phase II of the FORSCOM/USARC headquarters construction project has been announced by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers located in Savannah, Ga.

Construction firms selected for Phase II of the project are: A joint venture between Archer Western Contractors owned by the Walsh Group of Chicago, Ill. and Caddell Construction Company Inc. of Montgomery, Ala.; M. A. Mortenson Company headquartered in Minneapolis, Minn.; Hensel Phelps Construction Company headquartered in Greeley, Col.; and Gilbane Building Company headquartered in Providence, R.I.

These firms will submit Phase II proposals to include technical design and price information. The award will be made some time later this summer with groundbreaking this fall. Construction should be completed by early summer 2011. The anticipated cost range is \$250,000,000 to \$500,000,000.

Details of this Design-Build Request for Proposal include design services, site demolition and preparation, construction of utility infrastructure and approximately 650,000 square feet of Command Headquarters office space and associated communications buildings.

The FORSCOM/ USARC headquarters complex will replace the two existing U.S. Army Forces Command (FORSCOM) and U. S. Army Reserve Command (USARC) Headquarters at Fort McPherson, Ga., and relocate these command headquarters to Fort Bragg as directed by the Base Realignment and Closure (BRAC) actions approved by Congress in November of 2005.
