Tim Moore serves as a Program Manager for the BRAC Regional Task Force, a regional organization composed of 11 counties and 73 municipalities surrounding Fort Bragg. The BRAC RTF was organized to unify the community planning effort by coordinating the requirements and shortfalls for counties and municipalities affected by the 2005 BRAC actions at Fort Bragg and Pope AFB. Tim is responsible for implementing the U.S. Department of Labor (DOL) grant-funded Workforce Demonstration Program and developing the All American Center for Workforce Innovation to ensure that a highly skilled – high tech workforce is available to meet emerging military preparedness, defense and homeland security requirements.

Prior to joining the BRAC RTF, Tim worked for the N.C. Department of Commerce's Division of Workforce Development. He has also worked for the Center for Employment Training schools in Raleigh and Durham, the Durham Public School system, and Polaroid/Inner City, Inc., in Boston.

A native of New Jersey, Tim is a graduate of Ocean County College and received his undergraduate and graduate degrees in Industrial/ Career Counseling from Northeastern University in Boston.

Tim is a Certified Workforce Development Professional (CWDP) through the National Association of Workforce Development Professionals of which he is a member.
